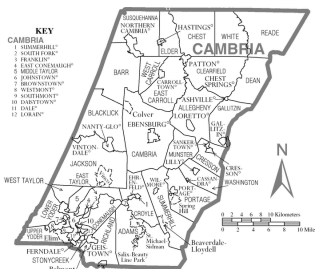
Facility Improvements
